

## **OLYMPIA STORY**

In 1945/46 the company was founded as Buchelt & Gennencher and produced electrical appliances, switches, ovens etc.

The factory was in Fichtestraße 3, Löbau Sachsen.







In 1949 the name changed to Elektrobau Werner Gennencher and they start to produce also the metal construction sets "Olympia".

There were two initial #00 and #0, three basic #1 to #3 and three accessory sets #0/1, #1/2 and #2/3. They used nickel-plated steel.

The main characteristics were:

Holes 2,0 mm

Pitch 7,0 mm

Screws and Nuts M2 External Diameter 1,9 mm (first brass after steel)

Rods Nickel plated Ø 1,9 mm

The production of metal sets probably ceased in 1955, but in my collection there is a manual and an antidust sheet booth marked 61.

In my collection there are 8 sets, 5 basic and 3 accessory
